



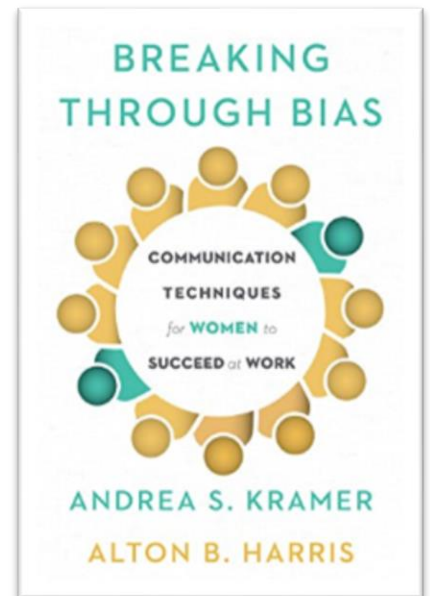
LEGACY PROJECT BOOK DISCUSSION
