




## Compliance Versus Ethics


- Compliance tells us what we must do

#### Values






## Overlapping Consensus\*

#### Human Value

- Instrumental Value: The value of a person based upon her skills.

#### **ILCMA Code of Ethics**


- The right to freedom from discrimination
