

Applying Strategies for Responding to Bias Incidents: Case Studies and Tabletop Exercise

Municipalities are often looked to for a response to bias incidents that occur within their community. During the lunch session, which supplements the morning ILCMA program, join local experts as they take a deeper dive into strategies for responding to bias incidents and equipping participants with the skills to decide when and how to engage. Discussion will focus on such topics as anti-Semitism, racism, gender bias, and anti-immigrant and anti-LGBTQIA rhetoric. This session will offer a framework for response planning. Police chiefs, PIO's, and communication staff are encouraged to attend.

Speakers *Dr. Lara Trubowitz and Ms. Daisha Muhammad* of the Anti-Defamation League will present attendees with case studies to work through scenarios and build confidence to assess interventions as individuals, with colleagues, and in partnership with community stakeholders.
